Fire Rated Fixture Protection Covers

DESCRIPTION

AF Cover Light are lightweight fire rated light covers for fluorescent lights, ceiling speakers and light fixtures. Tested EI 120 (120 minutes protection) following UNI EN 1365-2 also on plasterboards.

It is a mineral wool overlay thickness 10 mm content between two layers of glass material.

The outside layer is covered by a special aluminium foil, the inside layer by intumescent paint.

USES and ADVANTAGES

AF Cover Light are used to maintain the anti-fire protection on fire rated ceilings after the application of ceiling fixtures.

AF Cover Light prevent the passage of flames and insulate against heat. In case of fire the intumescent part expands and seals any gap preventing the fire from spreading further.
